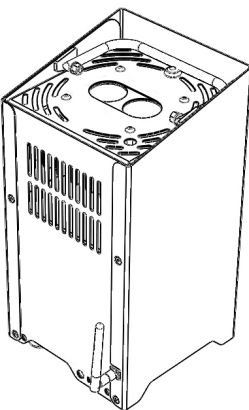

The following points should help maintain the long life of your LiteWare battery.

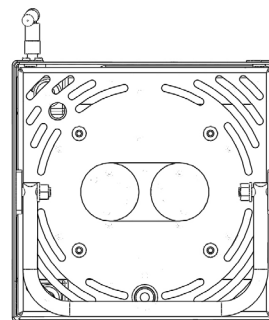
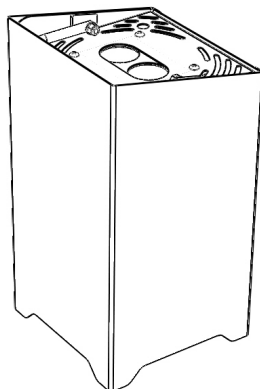
- 1). When in use, LiteWare automatically switches off when the battery voltage reaches a set lower limit. This is to avoid any deep discharge damage of the battery. It is not recommended LiteWare batteries are left for any prolonged period in this state.
- 2). LiteWare should always be re-charged as soon as practically possible to it's fully charged state. Once fully charged LiteWare can be stored.
- 3). We recommend, if LiteWare is to be unused for long periods, the LiteWare is charged every two months to keep the batteries topped up.
- 4). If LiteWare is stored in hotter environments (above 20 Degrees), we recommend a monthly storage charge.
- 5). From market data, the estimated number of uses in a normal environment, is around 200 cycles. This maybe higher if LiteWare is not run to 'turning off automatically' every time. We recommend replacing LiteWare battery every 2 Years.
- 6). Due to the large volumes of Batteries GDS purchase, we are able to offer a very competitive price on replacement batteries.

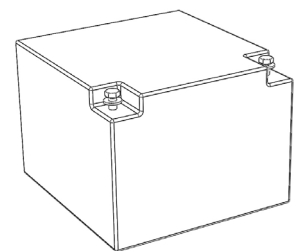
LiteWare HO/UL
